

# COVID-19: case 38

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72-years-old

female patient presented to the ED on March 5 with fever, diarrhea and dyspepsia for three days. She had contacts with a person affected with SARS COV

2. Physical examination: T 36.9°C, SpO<sub>2</sub>92%.

Blood tests at the hospitalization in the infectious disease department on March 7: WBC: 4.6; lymphocytes: 0.7U/L; RCP: 141mg/l.

Chest radiography:

Bilateral alveolar consolidations in the posterior regions of the inferior lobes. Subpleural nodules in the anterior segments of the left upper lobe. Multiple and diffuse ground glass opacities in all lobes. No pleural effusion.
